Insurance

All Wildfowlers require to hold Third Party Public Liability Insurance Cover for £5,000,000 minimum. Insurance must cover the entirety of the season. For any insurance cover that expires during the season, updated insurance details should be sent to Fife Council at the time of renewal. Any lapse in insurance cover will result in the permit being suspended until evidence of policy renewal is received. This is a condition of issue of the permit and it should be noted that **NO** permit will be issued unless proof has been provided that appropriate insurance cover is held by the applicant, e.g. BASC membership, copy of relevant section of household insurance policy etc.

General

All Wildfowlers will be required to follow the “Notes for Guidance of Wildfowlers” issued to Permit holders. Wildfowlers are requested to carefully complete the return on the Permit with details of **all** visits to the Reserve. It should also be noted that all Permits **must** be returned to the Fife Council **within 21 days** of the end of the season.

In order to aid the control of the Permit System, please notify any changes of address/vehicle registration number during the season promptly to avoid any unnecessary difficulties regarding identification of Wildfowlers by the Patrol Staff.
