

THE FIFE COUNCIL (A914 ST MICHAELS - 40MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2026

Fife Council propose to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to introduce a 40 mph speed limit on the A914 St Michaels approx. 30m north of the access road to Brackmont Mill southerly for approx. 560m.
