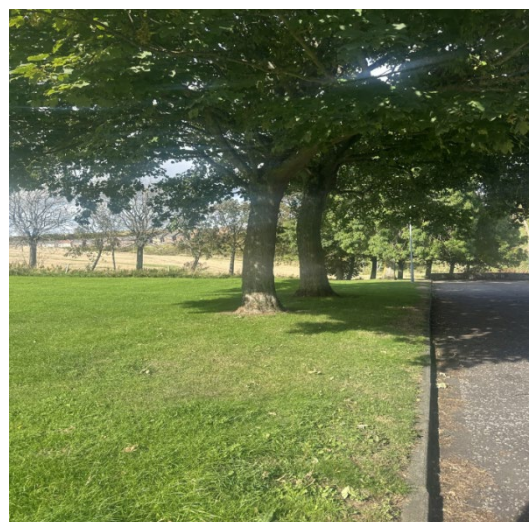
NOTICE OF CONSULTATION ON PROPOSED CHANGE OF USE OF COMMON GOOD LAND

Fife Council propose to change the use of Common Good land situated between Burnside Avenue and Mid Road, Kinghorn. The proposed path is shown coloured red on the plan below; this represents a shared use path that will support a new Active Travel route through Kinghorn. Before taking the decision, Fife Council requires to consult under Section 104 of the Community Empowerment (Scotland) Act 2015.

Facing North, the proposed path will run to the left of the trees shown above.

Please note: The plan above is intended solely to illustrate the proposed shared use path. The final alignment and layout may vary from that shown and will be subject to detailed design and implementation requirements.

Change of Use Request:

Fife Council is proposing to develop a new shared use path on Common Good land in Kinghorn as part of a wider Active Travel route that will be constructed between Burnside Avenue and the A921 Burntisland Road, Kinghorn. The proposed path will provide a safe and accessible route for pedestrians and cyclists, improving connectivity within the local area and encouraging sustainable travel choices. Upon completion, the route will be adopted and maintained by Fife Council as part of the Active Travel scheme.

The proposal is subject to statutory consents.
