

THE FIFE COUNCIL (RIVERSIDE TERRACE, KINCARDINE)
(TEMPORARY 18 TONNES WEIGHT RESTRICTION) ORDER 2013

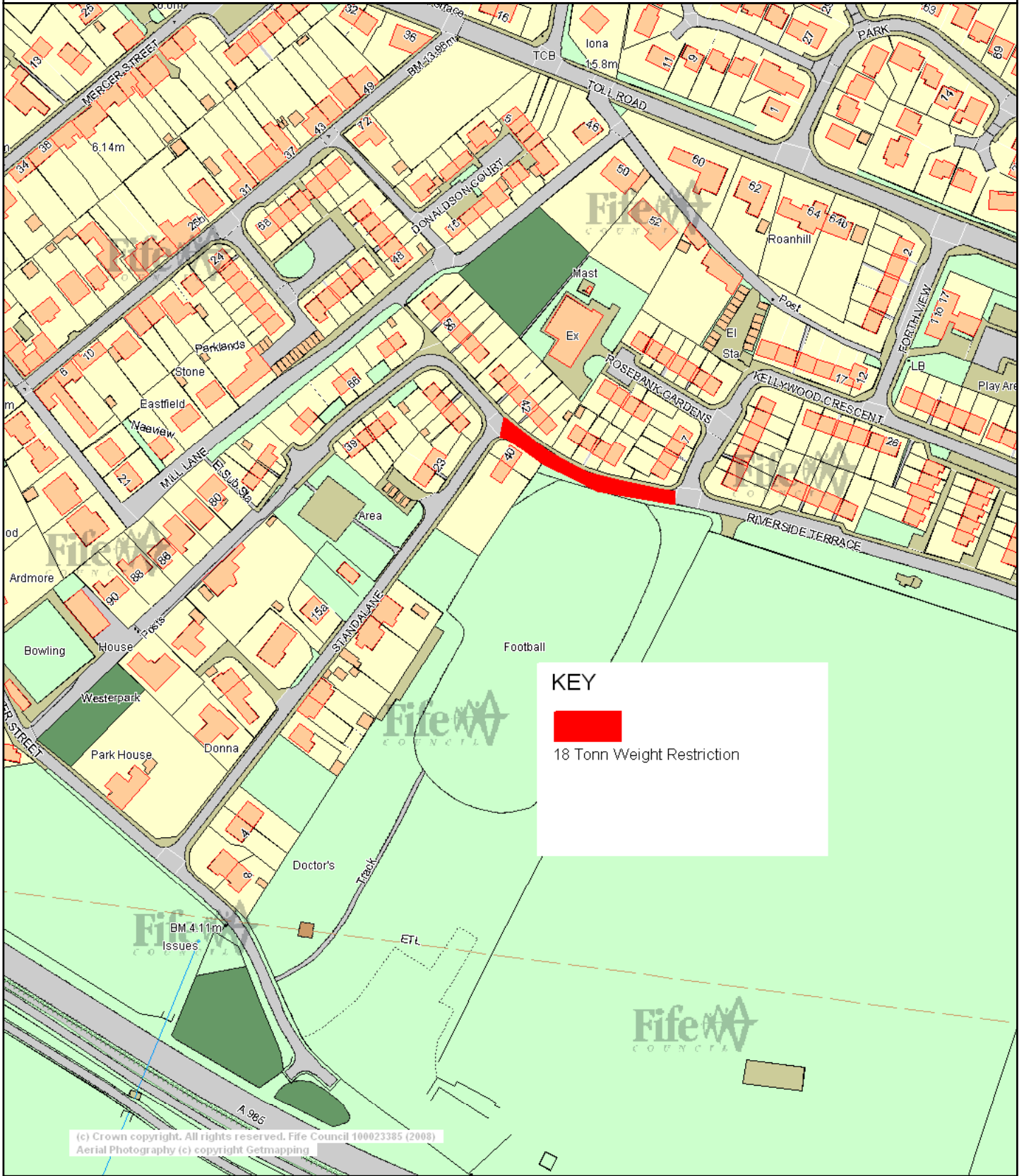
Fife Council has made an Order under section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles with a maximum gross weight exceeding 18 tonnes from using Riverside Terrace from Standalane to Kellywood Cres.

The purpose of the Order is to ensure safe passage across this section of road as a result of mine workings causing instability within the carriageway. The Order will come into effect on 18/02/13 and remain in operation until the works are completed. Upon completion of the works the Order shall be revoked and a further Notice will be published advising of this.

The alternative route for southbound vehicles with a maximum gross weight exceeding 18 tonnes will be via Kellywood Cres, Forth View, Toll Road (A977), North Approach Road (A876), Walker St and Standalane. The alternative route for northbound vehicles with a maximum gross weight exceeding 18 tonnes will be via Standalane, Walker St, North Approach Road (A876), Toll Road (A977), Forth View and Kellywood Cres.
