The proposal is subject to statutory consents.

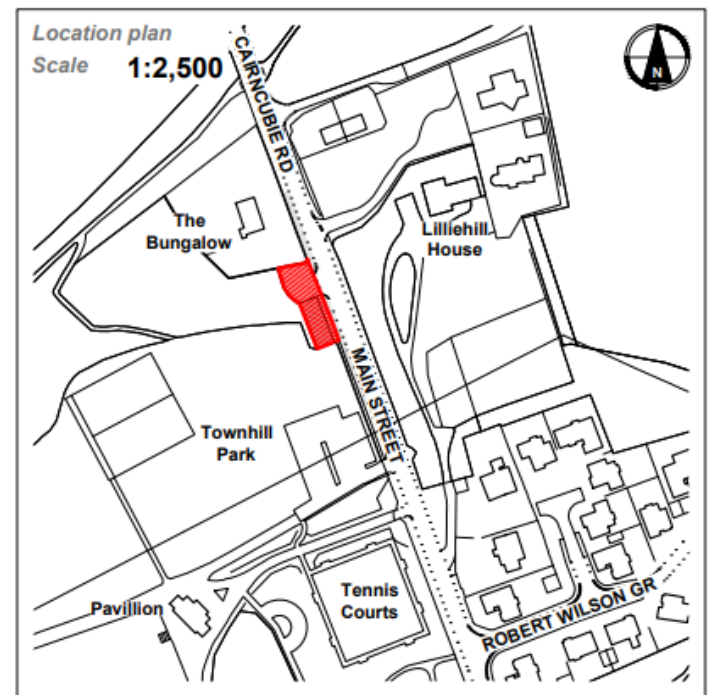
