

**THE FIFE COUNCIL (VARIOUS STREETS, TAYPORT - 20MPH SPEED LIMITS) ORDER
2026**

Fife Council propose to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to introduce a 20 m.p.h. speed limit on various streets in Tayport as follows:- Glebe Place for its entire length; Albert Street from the extended northwest property boundary of no. 5 Myrtle Terrace westerly to the extended west property boundary of no. 57 Albert Street; and Queen Street from approx. 32 metres south of the junction with Elizabeth Street southerly for approx. 338 metres.

Full details of the proposals may be examined during opening hours at Fife Council Headquarters, Fife House, North Street, Glenrothes and via public access pc's at your closest library. The documents will also be available online at www.fife.gov.uk/notices

THE FIFE COUNCIL (VARIOUS STREETS, TAYPORT - 20MPH SPEED LIMITS)
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The Fife Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them under section 84(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police for the Council's area in accordance with section 124 of and Part III of Schedule 9 to the said Act hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as "The Fife Council (Various Streets, Tayport - 20mph Speed Limits) Order 2026" and shall come into operation on the day of .
2. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour on the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
3. Nothing in this Order shall apply to any vehicle which falls within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
4. Drawing numbers TRO26_12a and TRO26_12b showing the roads affected by the Order delineated in red are annexed and signed as relative hereto.

Albert Street	From the extended northwest property boundary of no. 5 Myrtle Terrace in a westerly direction to the extended west property boundary of no. 57 Albert Street.
Queen Street	From a point 32 metres or thereby south of the junction with Elizabeth Street in a southerly direction for 338 metres or thereby.
