Annual Taxi/Private Hire Car Inspection Report

for August, September & October Tests – West Fife Area

Purpose:
To advise the Committee of the outcome of the Annual Taxi and Private Hire Car Inspection Tests for the West Fife Area.
Recommendation:
It is recommended that:
 random inspection tests, six months after the annual test dates, should be considered, where appropriate, to ensure public safety; and
(2) the Committee takes any other steps it deems appropriate.
Resource Implication:
Arrangements may have to be made for eight random inspection tests.
Legal & Risk Implications:
There is a possible public safety risk if no random inspections are carried out.

1.0 Background

- 1.1 This report gives details of the results of the inspections carried out on vehicles operating in West Fife in August, September & October 2021.
- 1.2 Of the 99 vehicles tested in West Fife, 91 passed first time which equated to 92%. The percentage pass rate in November, 2019 and August, 2019 was 99% and the percentage fail rate on these dates was 1%.
- 1.3 Summaries of the results and failures are attached in Appendix 1 to this report.

2.0 Issues and Options

- 2.1 As well as considering random testing of vehicles, the Committee, may deem it appropriate to:
 - ➤ invite those operators whose vehicles failed the test to a meeting with the Convener and Vice-Convener of the Committee to discuss their maintenance procedures; or
 - consider whether or not to hold Hearings under paragraph 11 of Schedule 1 to the Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982 which relates to suspension of the licences.

3.0 Conclusions

3.1 Although it's disappointing that this report shows a decrease in the first time pass rate from 2019, the Operators whose vehicles passed the test first time should be congratulated for their first class efforts in continuing to maintain their cars to a very high standard at this very difficult time.
