During this period the apprentice will participate in a programme of learning to develop skills and knowledge for repair and maintenance of Fife Councils motor fleet.</p> <p>The apprentice will work under supervision of a team of Mechanics to provide support and assistance with repair and maintenance duties to deliver a professional, high quality and customer focused service.</p> <p>Demonstrating an enthusiasm and willingness to learn and to work to a high degree of competence.</p>
Special Conditions:	<p>The apprentice will attend the appropriate college and training programme for development and must achieve milestone targets related to the completion of the SVQ Level 3 framework as agreed on the Individual Training Plan.</p> <p>Failure to meet these targets may result in the termination of the apprenticeship. In the case where an apprentice completes the SVQ framework an enhanced rate of pay will be awarded accordingly.</p> <p>Initial recruitment will be 1st year applicants only.</p>

Trade Apprentice vacancies are restricted to applicants who live in Fife. You must be aged between 16 and 24 on or by the advertised start date.

Alternatively successful applicants can start at 15 years old however your 16th birthday must be by 30th September within the year of recruitment. A School Leavers Form and National Insurance number will be required.
