The committee considered a report by the Head of Legal and Democratic Services on the Taxi Fare Scale Review 2025/26.

 - (ii) explain the effect of the proposed scales;
 - (iii) propose a date on which the proposed scales would come into effect; and

- (5) noted that the Head of Legal and Democratic Services would prepare a further report on any such representations received by the council for the consideration of the committee or, in the absence of any such representations, fix the scales and give further notice in accordance with the Act with delegation to set out, and explain the effect of, the scales as fixed and to set the date on which the scales as fixed would come into effect.

Annual Taxi/Private Hire Car Inspection Report for July to September 2025 - West Fife Area

1.0 Background

- 1.1 This report gives details of the results of the inspections carried out on vehicles operating in West Fife in July to September 2025.
- 1.2 Of the 170 vehicles tested in West Fife, 163 passed first time which equated to 96%, 7 vehicles failed but passed on re-test which equated to 4%. The percentage pass rate in March 2025 was 94%.
- 1.3 Summaries of the results are attached in Appendix 1 to this report.

2.0 Issues and Options

- 2.1 The Committee, may deem it appropriate to:
 - subject those vehicles failing the test to a random test;
 - invite those operators whose vehicles failed the test to a meeting with the Convener and Vice-Convener of the Committee to discuss their maintenance procedures;
 - request that those operators failing the test attend an open day at Fleet Operations; or
 - consider whether or not to hold Hearings under paragraph 11 of Schedule 1 to the Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982 which relates to suspension of the licences

3.0 Conclusions

- 3.1 I am delighted to report that the first-time pass rate has increased slightly, with many more vehicles being tested this time around. However, the Operators should be reminded that their vehicles should be maintained to a very high standard, at all times.
