Review of Statement of Licensing Policy

Purpose

The purpose of this report is to invite the Board to commence the review of the Board's Statement of Licensing Policy.

Recommendation(s)

The Board is asked to note the process for preparing a Statement of Licensing Policy, to consider the existing Statement and to provide comments to the Clerk on any matters in the Statement that members wish to examine as part of the review of Policy.

Resource Implications

Legal and Risk Implications

The review and publication of a Statement of Licensing Policy will fulfil the duty on the Board required by section 6 of the Licensing (Scotland) Act 2005.

Policy & Impact Assessment

An Equalities Impact Assessment has not been carried out at this stage but will be carried out, if required, prior to the adoption of the Statement of Licensing Policy.

Consultation

Consultation as required by the 2005 Act on the Board's proposed Statement of Licensing Policy will be carried out once the proposed Statement has been agreed by the Board.

1.0 Background

- 1.1 Every Licensing Board is required to publish a statement of their policy with respect to the exercise of their functions under the 2005 Act. The Statement must be published within 18 months after each ordinary election of councillors to the Council. This means that this Board's policy must be in place by 5 November 2023.
- 1.2 In preparing the Statement, the Board must ensure that the policy stated in the Statement seeks to promote the licensing objectives. Before publishing the Statement, consultation on the Statement must be carried out with the local Licensing Forum for the Board's area, the health board and such other persons as the Board thinks appropriate.
- 1.3 Each policy statement published by a licensing board must include a statement as to the extent to which the board considers there to be overprovision of licensed premises, or licensed premises of a particular description, in any locality within the Board's area. It is a decision for the Board to determine the localities. As a result of a change in the law in 2015, a Board may determine that the whole of the board's area is a locality. In considering whether there is overprovision, the board must have regard to the number and capacity of licensed premises in the locality and may have regard to other matters as the board thinks fit including the licensed hours of licensed premises in the locality. The Board must consult the chief constable, the health board, representatives of holders of premises licences and residents in the locality and such other persons as the Board thinks fit in considering whether there is overprovision.
- 1.4 The Board must have regard to the licensing policy statement in exercising their functions under the 2005 Act.
- 1.5 The current Statement of Licensing Policy has been circulated to members.

2.0 Issues and Options

- 2.1 The Fife Alcohol and Drug Partnership (ADP) is currently preparing an alcohol profile for Fife with NHS Fife taking the lead role. The ADP brings together representatives from NHS Fife, Police Scotland, Fife Council and other non-statutory sector drug and alcohol agencies. The alcohol profile will contain valuable information collated from the various representatives in the ADP which will assist the Board in the formulation of the Statement. The NHS Fife representative has indicated that work towards completion of the alcohol profile has been commenced and it is likely to take around ten weeks to complete. It is hoped the alcohol profile will be available for the Board to consider at a meeting in June 2023.
- 2.2 New statutory guidance on the 2005 Act was published by the Scottish Government in January 2023. The Board must have regard to the guidance in carrying out its functions under the Act. This updated guidance will assist the board in the preparation of the Statement.
- 2.3 Members are asked to consider the current Statement of Licensing Policy and identify any areas of the Statement which should be reviewed.

2.4 Following this meeting, future meetings will be arranged as and when required to discuss and review the Policy Statement. Thereafter, a draft Statement will be prepared for presentation to a future meeting of the Board most likely in May or June 2023. Once the Board finalises the draft Statement, it will be issued for consultation, hopefully during the summer recess to enable the Board to consider the responses to the consultation in late summer 2023. This timescale will give sufficient time for the Statement to be published in November 2023.

3.0 Conclusions

The Board is invited to consider the current Statement of Licensing policy and identify areas of the policy that should be reviewed.

1.0 Background

- 1.1 Fife Licensing Board has a written procedure to be followed when considering applications for premises licences. This procedure is contained at Appendix 3(b) of the Board's Statement of Licensing Policy. This procedure no longer accurately reflects the procedure followed when considering these types of applications.
- 1.2 There is reference in the Board's Statement of Licensing Policy at 1.24 to Hearings for Applications for Premises licences and Variation of premises Licences being undertaken in accordance with the procedures adopted as set out in Appendix 3(b). There is an omission within these written procedures as currently they do not include reference to the procedure to be followed when considering an Application for Variation of Premises Licence.
- 1.3 In terms of the Board's Rules set out at Appendix 3(a) of the Board's Statement of Licensing Policy, the Board can revise these written procedures from time-to-time and adopt new agreed procedures to be followed when considering applications for premises licence or to vary a premises licence.
- 1.4 The Board must follow its written procedures when dealing with applications for premises licence or applications to vary a premises licence.

2.0 Issues and Options

- 2.1 Members are asked to consider the proposed revised written procedures attached to this report.
- 2.2 Members are asked to agree to adopt the new proposed written procedures as set out in the attached document.
- 2.3 Members are asked to consider substituting the proposed written procedures for those currently set out at Appendix 3(b) of the Board's Statement of Licensing Policy.

3.0 Conclusions

The Board is invited to consider revising and agreeing the written procedure for considering applications for premises licences or to vary premises licences as set out in the 'Fife Licensing Board – Procedure for Applications for Premises Licences and Variation to Premises Licences' document attached to this report.

The Board is invited to substitute the revised written procedures referred to above into the Board's Statement of Licensing Policy at Appendix 3(b).

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PROCEDURE FOR APPLICATIONS FOR PREMISES LICENCES AND VARIATIONS TO PREMISES LICENCES

- 1. The **CONVENER** will ascertain whether or not the applicant is present or represented or both.
- 2. The **CLERK** will advise if there are Objections or Representations to the application and will ascertain whether or not the persons making these are present or represented or both.
- 3. The **CONVENER** will advise the applicant or their agent that unless they wish to make any preliminary submissions or remarks, the **BOARD** will proceed to hear the Objections/Representations. If there are any such preliminary submissions or remarks, any issues or questions arising should be dealt with at this stage.
- 4. If there are competent Objections or Representations the **CONVENER** will invite the persons making these to state their Objections or Representations. The **CONVENER** will also advise those persons that this is the only opportunity to speak to their objection/representation other than to answer any questions put to them by members of the **BOARD** or to make concluding remarks prior to the Board making a determination on the Application.
- 5. The **CLERK** will advise of any outstanding matters or other issues relating to the application, operating plan or layout plan.
- 6. The **CONVENER** will invite the applicant or their representative to speak to the application.
- 7. The **BOARD** may ask questions of the applicant, persons who have objected or made Representations and any other person in accordance with rules promulgated by the **BOARD**.
- 8. The **CONVENER** will invite those making representations or objections if they wish to make any concluding remarks.
- 9. The **CONVENER** will then invite the applicant or their representative if they wish to make any concluding remarks.
- 10. The **BOARD** will consider the application and reach a decision.
