New Parallel Zebra Crossing

Methilhaven Road – From a point 25 metres or thereby east of the extended east kerbline of Den Walk in an easterly direction for a distance of 8 metres or thereby.

Wellesley Road - From a point 25 metres or thereby north of the extended north kerbline of Kinnarchie Crescent in a northerly direction for a distance of 12 metres or thereby.

New Zebra Crossing

Kirkland Walk – From a point 9 metres or thereby east of the extended east kerbline of Methil Brae in an easterly direction for a distance of 3 metres or thereby.

Upgrade of Raised Zebra Crossing to Raised Parallel Zebra Crossing

Methil Brae – From a point 10 metres or thereby south of the extended south kerbline of Methilhaven Road in a southerly direction for a distance of 10 metres or thereby.

<u>Upgrade of Raised Zebra Crossing to Raised Toucan Crossing</u>

Methilhaven Road – From a point 40 metres or thereby east of the extended east kerbline of Kirkland Drive in an easterly direction for a distance of 7 metres or thereby.

Methilhaven Road – From a point 15 metres or thereby west of the extended west kerbline of Methil Brae in a westerly direction for a distance of 7 metres or thereby.
