

## Blue Badge Application Replacement Badge – Lost, Stolen or Damaged

You can apply for a replacement Blue Badge using this form if your badge has been lost, stolen or damaged.

If your badge has been lost or stolen, you must report this to the Police. You will need to provide either the Lost Property Report Number or the Crime Reference Number given to you by the Police. If your badge has been damaged, you will need to give a full explanation of the circumstances, and the date on which the damage occurred. You must enclose your damaged badge with this form or if your lost/stolen badge is returned to you, you must return it to Fife Council immediately.

Please complete all sections of this form. Failure to complete any part or to supply the required information may result in the form being returned to you and a delay in issuing a replacement.

Completed forms can be handed into any Local Office (phone 03451 55 00 66) for the details and opening hours of your nearest office) or posted to Blue Badge Team, Fife Council, Bankhead Central, Glenrothes, KY7 6GH

Note: From 1 April 2016, lost, stolen or damaged badges will be subject to a £20 charge. This will be requested upon approval of your replacement badge. Payment should not be sent with your application.
