

B925 KIRKCALDY ROAD, CROSSGATES - TRAFFIC CALMING

Notice is hereby given in terms of Section 37 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984 that Fife Council propose to introduce road humps in the form of speed cushions and a raised table as follows:-

Speed Cushions (3m x 75mm) B925 Kirkcaldy Road from a point 14 metres or thereby east of the extended east kerbline of Gallows Knowe in an easterly direction; and from a point 14 metres or thereby east of the extended east kerbline of Blackhill Brae in an easterly direction.

Raised table (10m x 100mm) B925 Kirkcaldy Road from a point 24 metres or thereby west of the extended west kerbline of C26 in a westerly direction.

Full details of the proposals may be examined during opening hours at Fife Council Headquarters, Fife House, North Street, Glenrothes and via public access pc's at your closest library. The documents will also be available online at www.fife.gov.uk/notices
