Annual Taxi/Private Hire Car Inspection Report for April to July, 2022 - East Fife Area

Report by: Billy Ferguson, Service Manager, Fleet Operations

Wards Affected: 17, 18, 19, 20 and 21

Purpose:

To advise the Committee of the outcome of the Annual Taxi and Private Hire Car Inspection Tests for the East Fife Area.

Recommendation:

It is recommended that:

- (1) random inspection tests, six months after the annual test dates, should be considered, where appropriate, to ensure public safety; and
- (2) the Committee takes any other steps it deems appropriate.

Resource Implication:

Arrangements may have to be made for 11 random inspection tests.

Legal & Risk Implications:

There is a possible public safety risk if no random inspections are carried out.

Policy & Impact Assessment:

- 1.1 This report gives details of the results of the inspections carried out on vehicles operating in East Fife between April and July 2022.
- 1.2 Of the 208 vehicles tested in East Fife, 197 vehicles passed first time which equated to 95%. 11 vehicles failed the test then passed on retest which equated to 5%.
- 1.3 Summaries of the results are attached in Appendix 1 to this report.

2.0 Issues and Options

- 2.1 As well as considering random testing of vehicles, the Committee, may deem it appropriate to:
 - invite those operators whose vehicles failed the test to a meeting with the Convener and Vice Convener of the Committee to discuss their maintenance procedures; or
 - consider whether or not to hold a Hearing under paragraph 11 of Schedule 1 to the Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982 which relates to suspension of the licence.

3.0 Conclusions

3.1 The first-time pass rate has decreased slightly since 2019. However, the Operators should still be congratulated for their first-class efforts in continuing to maintain their cars to a very high standard particularly at this very difficult time.

Annual Taxi/Private Hire Car Inspection Report for April to June Tests - Levenmouth Zone

Purpose:

To advise the Committee of the outcome of the Annual Taxi and Private Hire Car Inspection Tests for the Levenmouth Zone.

Recommendation:

It is recommended that:

- (1) random inspection tests, six months after the annual test dates, should be considered, where appropriate, to ensure public safety; and
- (2) the Committee takes any other steps it deems appropriate.

Resource Implication:

Arrangements may have to be made for two random inspection tests.

Legal & Risk Implications:

There is a possible public safety risk if no random inspections are carried out.

Policy & Impact Assessment:

None

Consultation:

None

- 1.1 This report gives details of the results of the inspections carried out on vehicles operating in Levenmouth Zone from April to June 2022.
- 1.2 Of the 91 vehicles licensed in Levenmouth, 89 passed first time, which equates to 98%, 2 failed and passed on re-test equating to 2%. The percentage pass rate in 2020 was 99%.
- 1.3 Summaries of the results and failures are attached in Appendix 1 to this report.

2.0 Issues and Options

- 2.1 As well as considering random testing of vehicles, the Committee, may deem it appropriate to:
 - invite those operators whose vehicles failed the test to a meeting with the Convener and Vice Convener of the Committee to discuss their maintenance procedures; or
 - consider whether or not to hold a Hearing under paragraph 11 of Schedule 1 to the Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982 which relates to suspension of the licence.

3.0 Conclusions

3.1 The first-time pass rate has decreased slightly since 2020. However, the Operators should still be congratulated for their first-class efforts in continuing to maintain their cars to a very high standard particularly at this very difficult time.

Recommendation:

It is recommended that:

- (1) random inspection tests, six months after the annual test dates, should be considered, where appropriate, to ensure public safety; and
- (2) the Committee takes any other steps it deems appropriate.

Resource Implication:

Arrangements may have to be made for two random inspection tests.

Legal & Risk Implications:

There is a possible public safety risk if no random inspections are carried out.

Policy & Impact Assessment:

Consultation:

- 1.1 This report gives details of the results of the inspections carried out on vehicles operating in West Fife between May and June, 2022.
- 1.2 Of the 78 vehicles tested in West Fife, 76 passed first time which equated to 97%. Two vehicles failed but passed on retest which equated to 3%. The percentage pass rate in January 2022 was 95% and the percentage fail rate at that time was 5%.
- 1.3 Summaries of the results are attached in Appendix 1 to this report.

2.0 Issues and Options

- 2.1 As well as considering random testing of vehicles, the Committee, may deem it appropriate to:
 - invite those operators whose vehicles failed the test to a meeting with the Convener and Vice Convener of the Committee to discuss their maintenance procedures; or
 - consider whether or not to hold a Hearing under paragraph 11 of Schedule 1 to the Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982 which relates to suspension of the licence.

3.0 Conclusions

3.1 The first-time pass rate has increased slightly since January. The Operators should be congratulated for their first-class efforts in continuing to maintain their cars to a very high standard particularly at this very difficult time.

Cinemas Act 1985 – Variation of Licensing Conditions - The Byre Theatre, Abbey Street, St. Andrews – During September and November 2022

Purpose:

The Council has received a request for authorisation to screen uncertified films at the Byre Theatre, St. Andrews

Recommendation:

It is recommended that the Committee:

- (i) notes this report; and
- (ii) grants permission to allow specific uncertificated films, from the list of titles circulated, to be shown on specific dates in September and November 2022 at the Byre Theatre, St. Andrews

- 1.1 In August 2022 the Council received notice from a representative of the Byre Theatre regarding films due to be screened on specific dates in September and November, 2022.
- Typically most of these films are yet to be released and have still to be classified by the BBFC. Therefore, as required by the Council's Standard Conditions of Licence, the Byre Theatre is seeking permission for the films within the programme to be shown. The committee has previously agreed to similar variations.
- 1.3 Committee members should note that any permitted variation would relate only to the films specified on the list circulated to members, and any films not so specified would be required to adhere to the Council's Standard Conditions of Licence.
- 1.4 This permission will apply, as appropriate, to the Byre Theatre on specific dates in September and November, 2022 only.

2.0 Conclusions

2.1 Condition 3 of the Council's standard conditions, which applies to all cinema licences, states that:

No film shall be exhibited unless -

- (a) it has received a "Uc", "U", "PG", "12A", "12", "15" or "18" certificate of the British Board of Film Classification; or
- (b) it is a current news-reel which has not been submitted to the British Board of Film Classification.

Full conditions are attached at Appendix 1.

- 2.2 However, condition 7 of the cinema licence conditions states a film may be exhibited, or persons or any class of persons, may be admitted thereto if the permission of the Licensing Authority is first obtained and any conditions of such permission are complied with.
- 2.3 The Committee has given approval for certain venues to show uncertificated films in previous years.

CONDITIONS

- 1. The licence holder or the responsible manager, his deputy for the time being or occupier of the premises shall immediately communicate to the Chief Fire Officer of Fife Fire and Rescue Service any outbreak of fire, however slight.
- 2. All attendants on duty to assist persons entering or leaving the auditorium shall wear a distinguishing uniform, armband or badge.
- 3. No film shall be exhibited unless -
 - (a) it has received a "Uc", "U", "PG", "12A", "12", "15" or "18" certificate of the British Board of Film Classification; or
 - (b) it is a current news-reel which has not been submitted to the British Board of Film Classification.
- 4. No person under the age of 18 years shall be admitted to any exhibition at which there is to be shown any film which has received an "18" certificate from the British Board of Film Classification.
- 5. No person under the age of 15 years shall be admitted to any exhibition at which there is to be shown any film which has received a "15" certificate from the British Board of Film Classification.
- 6. No person under the age of 12 years shall be admitted to any exhibition at which there is to be shown any film which has received a "12A" certificate from the British Board of Film Classification unless they are accompanied during the showing of the film by a person of 18 years or over.
- 7. Notwithstanding the conditions hereinbefore contained, a film may be exhibited, or persons or any class of persons, may be admitted thereto if the permission of the Licensing Authority is first obtained and any conditions of such permission are complied with.
- 8. A representation or written statement of the terms of any certificate given by the British Board of Film Classification shall be shown on the screen immediately before the showing of any film to which it relates and the representation or statement shall be shown for long enough and in a form large enough for it to be read from any seat in the auditorium.
- 9. There shall be prominently exhibited at each public entrance whenever the premises are open to the public a notice indicating in tabular form and in clear bold letters and figures -
 - (a) the title of each film to be shown on that day, other than trailers and films of less than five minutes duration;
 - (b) the approximate times of commencement of each such films;
 - (c) whether each such film has received a "Uc", "U", "PG", "12A", "12", "15" or "18" certificate from the British Board of Film Classification.
 - (d) The effect of such "Uc", "U", "PG", "12A", "12", "15" or "18" certificates in relation to the admission of persons under the age of 18 years.
- 10. The nature of any certificate received in respect of a film from the British Board of Film Classification shall be clearly indicated by the letter "Uc", "U", "PG", "12A", "12", "15" or "18" in any advertisement of the film displayed at the premises.

- 11. No advertisement displayed at the premises of a film to be exhibited at the premises shall depict as a scene or incident in the film any scene or incident which is not included in the film as certified by the British Board of Film Classification or approved for exhibition by the Licensing Authority, as the case may be.
- 12. Where the Licensing Authority has given notice in writing to the licence holder of the premises objecting to an advertisement on the grounds that, if displayed, it would offend against good taste or decency or be likely to encourage or incite to crime or to lead to disorder or to be offensive to public feeling, that advertisement shall not be displayed at the premises except with the consent in writing of the Licensing Authority.
- 13. Where the Licensing Authority has given notice in writing to the licence holder of the premises prohibiting the exhibition of a film on the ground that it contains matter which, if exhibited, would offend against good taste or decency or would be likely to encourage or incite to crime or to lead to disorder or to be offensive to public feeling, that film shall not be exhibited in the premises except with the consent in writing of the Licensing Authority.

Taxi Fare Scale Review

Purpose:

The purpose of this report is to seek authority, from the Committee, to commence the procedures for the 2022 review of the Taxi Fare Scales.

Recommendation:

It is recommended that the Committee makes arrangements to hold a consultative meeting to discuss any representations or proposals.

Resource Implication:

Staff time in carrying out consultations, arranging ad-hoc review Sub-Committee meetings and, if necessary, recalibrating meters.

Legal & Risk Implications:

There is a statutory requirement to complete the review within 18 months.

Policy & Impact Assessment:

Review may alter income levels of taxi/private hire car operators as well as costs to users of taxis/private hire cars.

- 1.1 In terms of the Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982, Taxi Fare Scales require to be reviewed on a regular basis. After consultation with Taxi Associations in Fife, the current arrangement is that taxi fares should be reviewed on an annual basis. However, this has been deferred due to the coronavirus pandemic.
- 1.2 The last Review came into operation on 2nd December, 2019 and, following consultations with the Taxi Associations/Taxi Operators in the forthcoming Review, any changes will be implemented on 5th December, 2022.

2.0 Issues and Options

- 2.1. Consultations require to be carried out with the Taxi Association/Taxi Operators before the Committee takes a decision on the Review.
- 2.2 In 2019 the consultations were carried out by a Sub-Committee of this Committee which consisted of the Convener, Vice-Convener and six other members and it is suggested that a similar arrangement should be continued, if necessary.

3.0 Conclusions

- 3.1 In order to enable a decision to be taken by this Committee and still allow appropriate time for advertising and the lodging of appeals, if any, a decision on the Review will require to be taken by this Committee at its meeting on 6th September, 2022.
- 3.2 A report, therefore, will be submitted to this Committee on 6th September, 2022 for a decision on what the fare scale will be for the 12 months following 5th December, 2022.
