THE FIFE COUNCIL (WINDYGATES/KENNOWAY/BONNYBANK/BAINTOWN - 20 M.P.H. SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2026

Fife Council propose to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to introduce a 20 m.p.h. speed limit on the following lengths of road: - **Windygates** – The entire lengths of A916 Leven Rd and A916 Kennoway Rd; **Kennoway** – The entire lengths of A916 Sandy Brae, A916 New Rd and A916 Cupar Rd; **Bonnybank** – The entire lengths of A916 Cupar Rd and A916 Cupar Rd between Kennoway and Bonnybank and **Baintown** – U029 from jct. A916 Cupar Rd, Bonnybank westerly for approx. 640m. The Order will also have the effect of revoking “The Fife Council (Baintown and Bonnybank – 30 m.p.h. speed limit) Order 2017” in its entirety.

THE FIFE COUNCIL (WINDYGATES/KENNOWAY/BONNYBANK/BAINTOWN - 20 M.P.H. SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2026

The Fife Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them under section 84(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police for the Council's area in accordance with section 124 of and Part III of Schedule 9 to the said Act hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as "The Fife Council (Windygates/Kennoway/Bonnybank/Baintown - 20 m.p.h. Speed Limit) Order 2026" and shall come into operation on the _____ day of _____, Two Thousand and Twenty Six.
2. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour on the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
3. The Fife Council (Baintown and Bonnybank – 30 m.p.h Speed Limit) Order 2007 is hereby revoked.
4. Nothing in this Order shall apply to any vehicle which falls within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
5. Drawing numbers TRO25/86, TRO25/87, TRO25/88 and TRO25/107 showing the roads affected by this Order delineated in black are annexed and signed as relative hereto

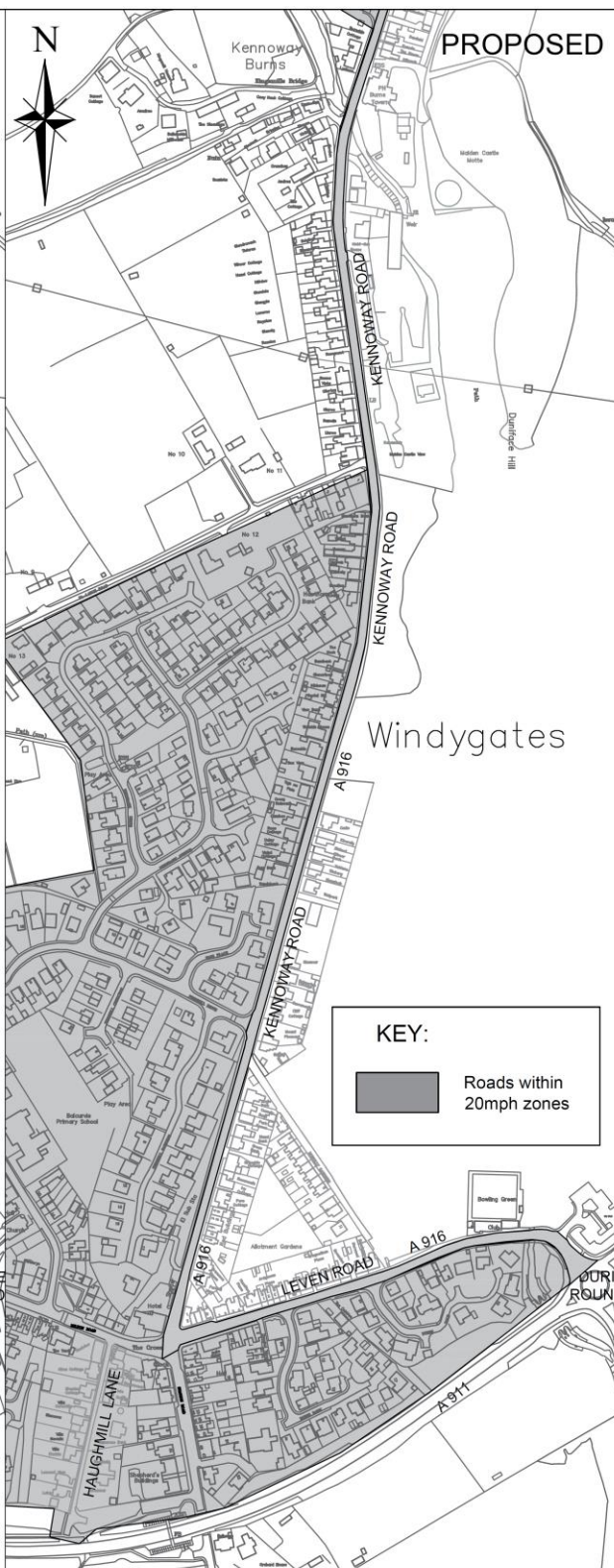
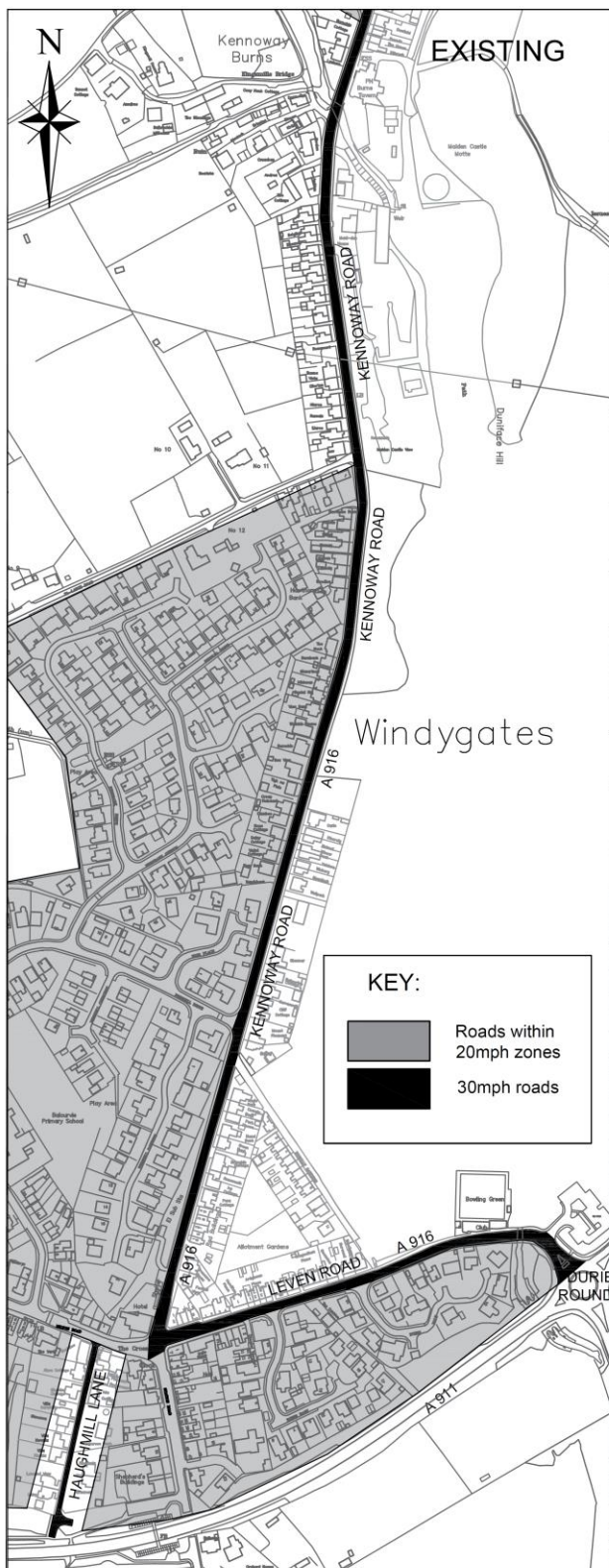

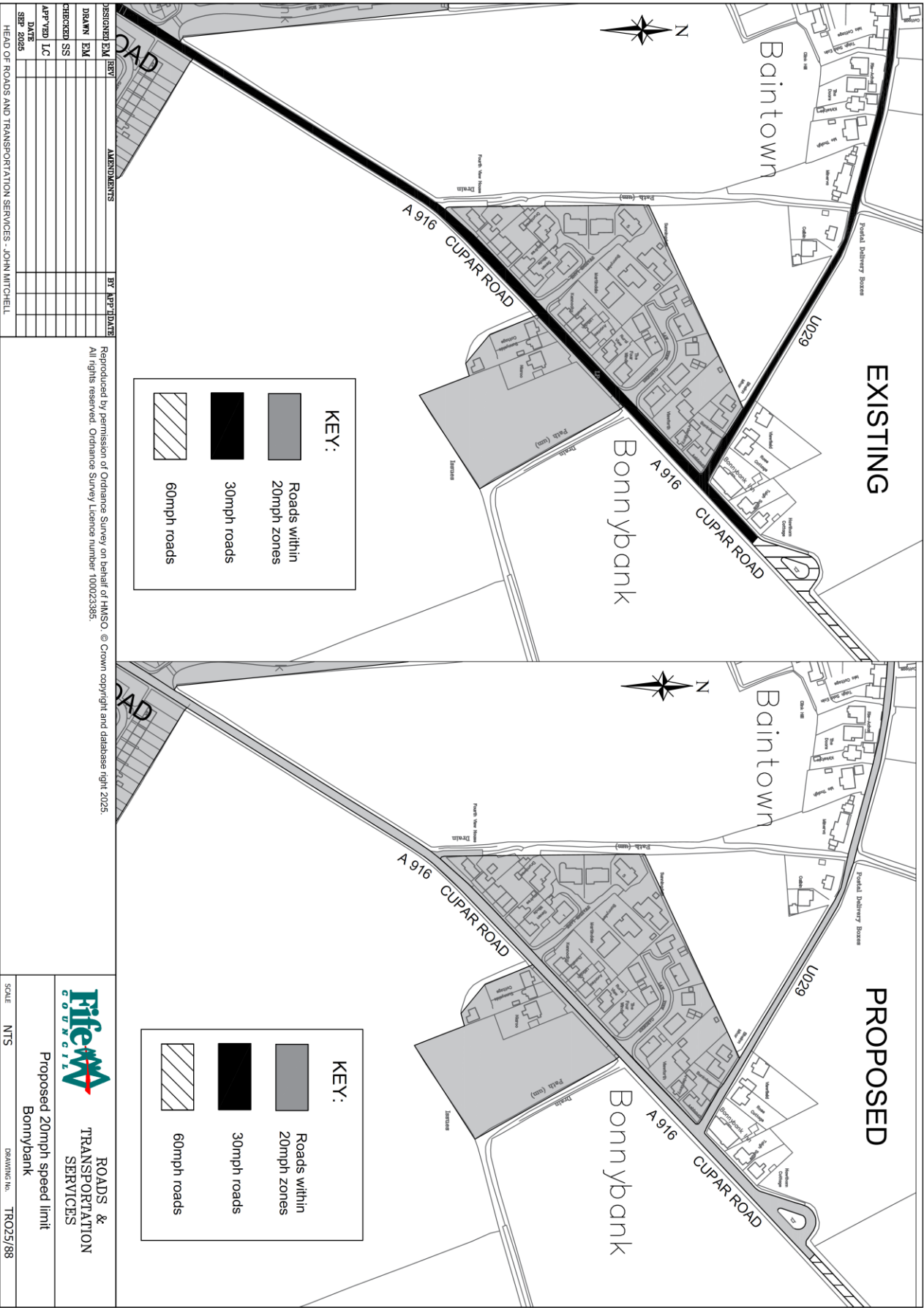
