This was in relation to the provision of CPR training for out of hospital management of Cardiac Arrest including the use of Public Access Defibrillators in all our Secondary Schools.

What is now the longest time someone has been waiting for their HFNA in Fife?

What percentage of people waiting for a HFNA in Fife have now been waiting from longer than the four week maximum waiting time set out in the Council's Housing Allocations Policy?
