

**THE FIFE COUNCIL (VARIOUS STREETS, CAIRNEYHILL) (SPEED LIMITS)**  
**ORDER 2025**

Fife Council propose to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to introduce speed limits on the A994, Flaxfield Crescent and Handweavers Court as follows:- **20 m.p.h.speed limit** – all roads constructed or to be constructed within the new housing development to the north of A994 to be known as Flaxfield Crescent and Handweavers Court. **30 m.p.h speed limit** – A994 from approx. 25m west of Glen Moriston Dr to Cairneyhill roundabout A985 for approx.. 105m

**THE FIFE COUNCIL (VARIOUS STREETS, CAIRNEYHILL) (SPEED LIMITS)**  
**ORDER 2025**

The Fife Council ("the Council") in exercise of the powers conferred on them under sections 84(1) and 124(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police for the Council's area in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the said Act hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as "The Fife Council (Various Streets, Cairneyhill) (Speed Limits) Order 2025" and shall come into operation on the \_\_\_\_\_ day of Two Thousand and Twenty Five.
2. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour on the length of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order.
3. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour on the length of road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order.
4. Nothing in this Order shall apply to any vehicle which falls within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
5. Drawing number TRO24\_56 showing the roads affected by this Order delineated in black is annexed and signed as relative hereto.
