

THE FIFE COUNCIL (A917, ST MONANS - 40MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2026

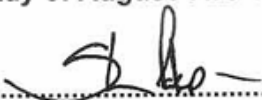

THE FIFE COUNCIL (A917, ST MONANS - 40MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2026

The Fife Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them under sections 84(1) and 124(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police for the Council's area in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the said Act hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as "The Fife Council (A917, St Monans - 40mph Speed Limit) Order 2026" and shall come into operation on the First day of September Two Thousand and Twenty Six.
2. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
3. Nothing in this Order shall apply to any vehicle which falls within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
4. Drawing number TRO25_103 showing the roads affected by this Order delineated in red is annexed and signed as relative hereto.

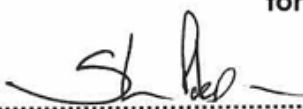
