

**7/7/25 THE FIFE COUNCIL (CUPAR ROAD & KIRK ROAD, NEWPORT-ON-TAY – 20
M.P.H. SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2025**

Fife Council propose to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to introduce a 20 m.p.h. speed limit on **Cupar Road** from the junction with Kirk Road northerly for approx. 178m; and from the junction with Kirk Road southerly for approx. 300m; and **Kirk Road** from the junction with Cupar Road westerly for approx. 513m.

**THE FIFE COUNCIL (CUPAR ROAD & KIRK ROAD, NEWPORT-ON-TAY – 20
M.P.H. SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2025**

The Fife Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them under section 84(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police for the Council's area in accordance with section 124 of and Part III of Schedule 9 to the said Act hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as "The Fife Council (Cupar Road & Kirk Road, Newport-on-Tay – 20 m.p.h. Speed Limit) Order 2025" and shall come into operation on the _____ day of _____ 2025.
2. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour on the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
3. Nothing in this Order shall apply to any vehicle which falls within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
4. The Fife Council (Newport Primary School – Part Time 20 m.p.h Speed Limit) Order 2004 is hereby revoked.
5. Drawing numbers TRO25_12-1 and TRO25_12-2 showing the roads affected by this Order delineated in black is annexed and signed as relative hereto.
