THE FIFE COUNCIL (VARIOUS STREETS, CUPAR – 20 M.P.H. SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2025

The Fife Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by sections 84(1) and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police for the Council's area in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the said Act hereby make the following Order:-

- This Order may be cited as "The Fife Council (Various Streets, Cupar 20 m.p.h. Speed Limit) Order 2025" and shall come into operation on the Eleventh day of July Two Thousand and Twenty Five.
- No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour on the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
- The Fife Council (Castlehill Primary School, Cupar 20 m.p.h. Speed Limit)
 Order 2006 shall be amended as follows:-

The following shall be removed from the end of Schedule 2:-

- "South Road, from a point 230 metres or thereby northwest of the extended north kerbline of St Michaels's Drive in a southerly direction for a distance of 595 metres or thereby"
- 4. The Fife Council (Bell Baxter High School, Cupar Part Time 20 m.p.h. Speed Limit) Order 2008 shall be revoked entirely.
- Nothing in this Order shall apply to any vehicle which falls within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
- Drawing numbers TRO23_63-1, TRO23_63-2, TRO23_63-3 and TRO23_63-6 showing the roads affected by this Order delineated in black is annexed and signed as relative hereto.
