

**THE FIFE COUNCIL (B939, STRATHKINNESS CROSSROADS - 40MPH SPEED LIMIT)
ORDER 2026**



The Fife Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them under section 84(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police for the Council's area in accordance with section 124 of and Part III of Schedule 9 to the said Act hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as "The Fife Council (B939, Strathkinness Crossroads - 40mph Speed Limit) Order 2026" and shall come into operation on the Second day of March Two Thousand and Twenty Six.
2. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
3. Nothing in this Order shall apply to any vehicle which falls within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
4. Drawing number TRO25_85 showing the roads affected by this Order delineated in red is annexed and signed as relative hereto.

SCHEDULE

B939	From a point 300 metres or thereby west of the extended west kerbline of the C4, Main Street in an easterly direction for a distance of 700 metres or thereby.
C4, Main Street	From its junction with the B939 in a northerly direction for a distance of 80 metres or thereby.
C4 (south of B939)	From its junction with the B939 in a southerly direction for a distance of 80 metres or thereby.
