By submitting your application, you, the applicant, or the applicant's agent agree to the following statements:

You declare that:

- The information you have given on this form is correct and complete.

You understand that:

- You must promptly tell the Scottish Welfare Fund of any further information or change of circumstances which may affect your application even if you have been awarded but haven't yet received the award.
- You agree that if your award is paid in cash, you will spend it on the items for which it was made and if requested will provide receipts to confirm this.
- You agree that if you use goods or cash awarded for any other purpose than what was agreed, we have the right to withdraw or refuse future Scottish Welfare Fund applications, this includes selling your award to a third party.
- The Scottish Welfare Fund may make enquiries about the information provided to support your application and to prevent fraud. If you receive an award from the Scottish Welfare Fund by providing incorrect details, or not giving us full details or providing false or fraudulent information, you could be prosecuted, and we may seek to recover funds.

You agree that:

- Fife Council is administering the Scottish Welfare Fund and personal information which you supply will be used to assess and process your application.
- We may check the information you provide with other sources such as DWP, Social Security Scotland, Housing Services, Social Work Services, Police Scotland, and any other emergency services. We may also share information with these sources to support your application, make sure the information is accurate, prevent or detect crime & fraud and protect public funds.
