

VARIOUS STREETS, ROSYTH - TOUCAN CROSSINGS

Notice is hereby given in terms of section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 that Fife Council propose to install and remove crossings in Rosyth as follows:

Install

Admiralty Park approx. 40m south of the southern end of the north island of A985/Admiralty roundabout; Brankholme Brae approx. 25m north of the northern end of the north island of A985/Brankholme Brae roundabout; Castle Road approx. 50m north of the extended north kerbline of Peasehill Road; Castle Road approx. 10m south of the southern end of the southern island of A985/Brankholme roundabout; and Castlelandhill Road approx. 30m south of the extended south kerbline of Ridley Drive.

Remove

Castle Road approx. 130m north of the extended north kerbline of Peasehill Road.
