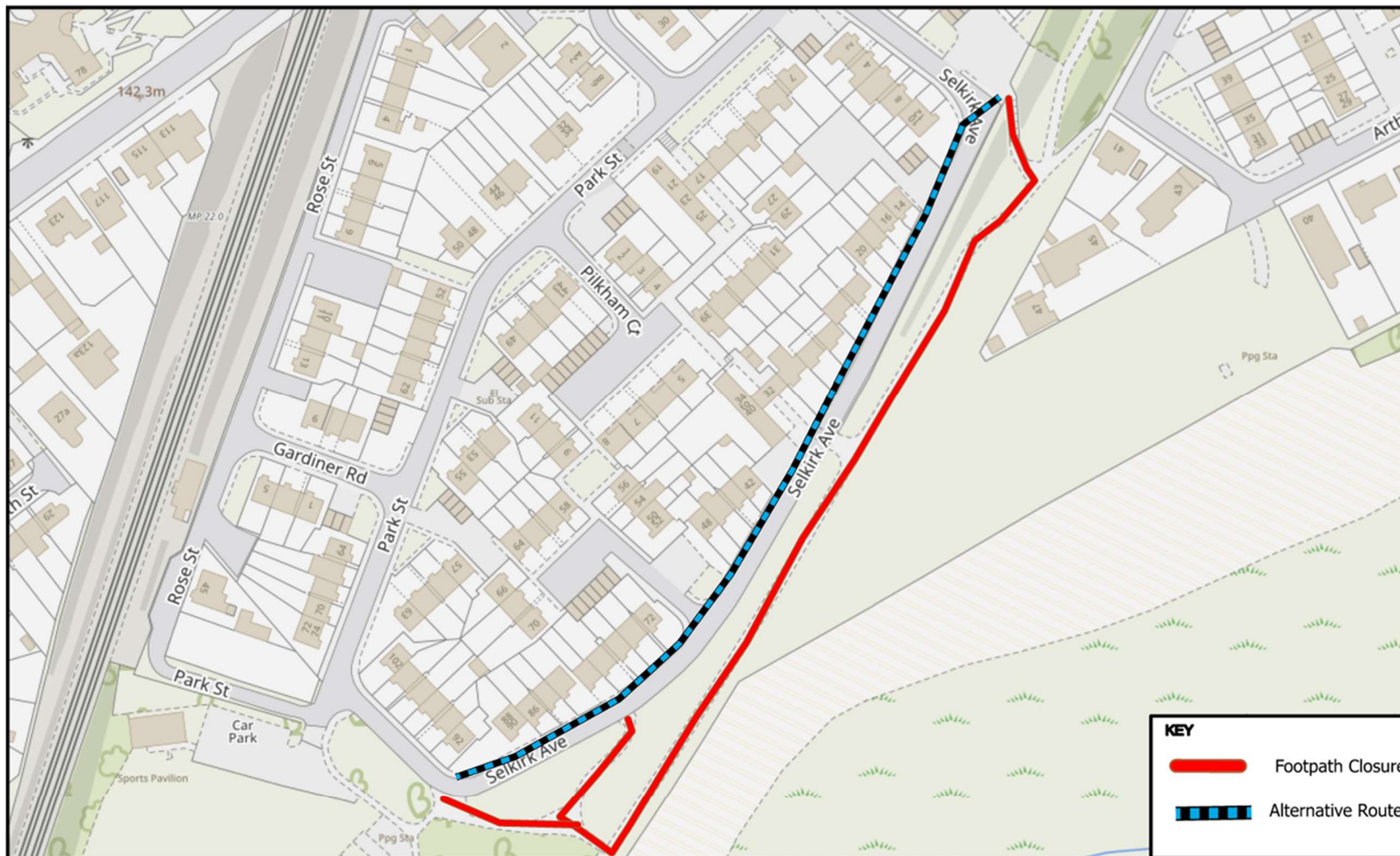


Temporary Footpath Closure

- WHERE ?** Railway Path, Cowdenbeath
Section 1 – Adjacent to Selkirk Avenue
The alternative route for pedestrians is via Selkirk Avenue.
Section 2 – Between Selkirk Avenue & Seco Place
The alternative route for pedestrians is via Selkirk Avenue, Raith Avenue, Broad Street, High Street, McLeod Drive, McLeod Drive to Seco Place Footpath, Seco Place, Church Street & Primmer Place.
Section 3 – Between McLeod Drive & Factory Road
The alternative route for pedestrians is via McLeod Drive, High Street, Station Road & Factory Road.
- Access for emergency service vehicles will be maintained.
- WHEN ?** Daily between 8am and 4.30pm from Monday 7th September 2026 to Friday 23rd October 2026 (these works will be phased as indicated by the contractor on site).
- WHY ?** To allow street lighting installation works to be carried out in safety.

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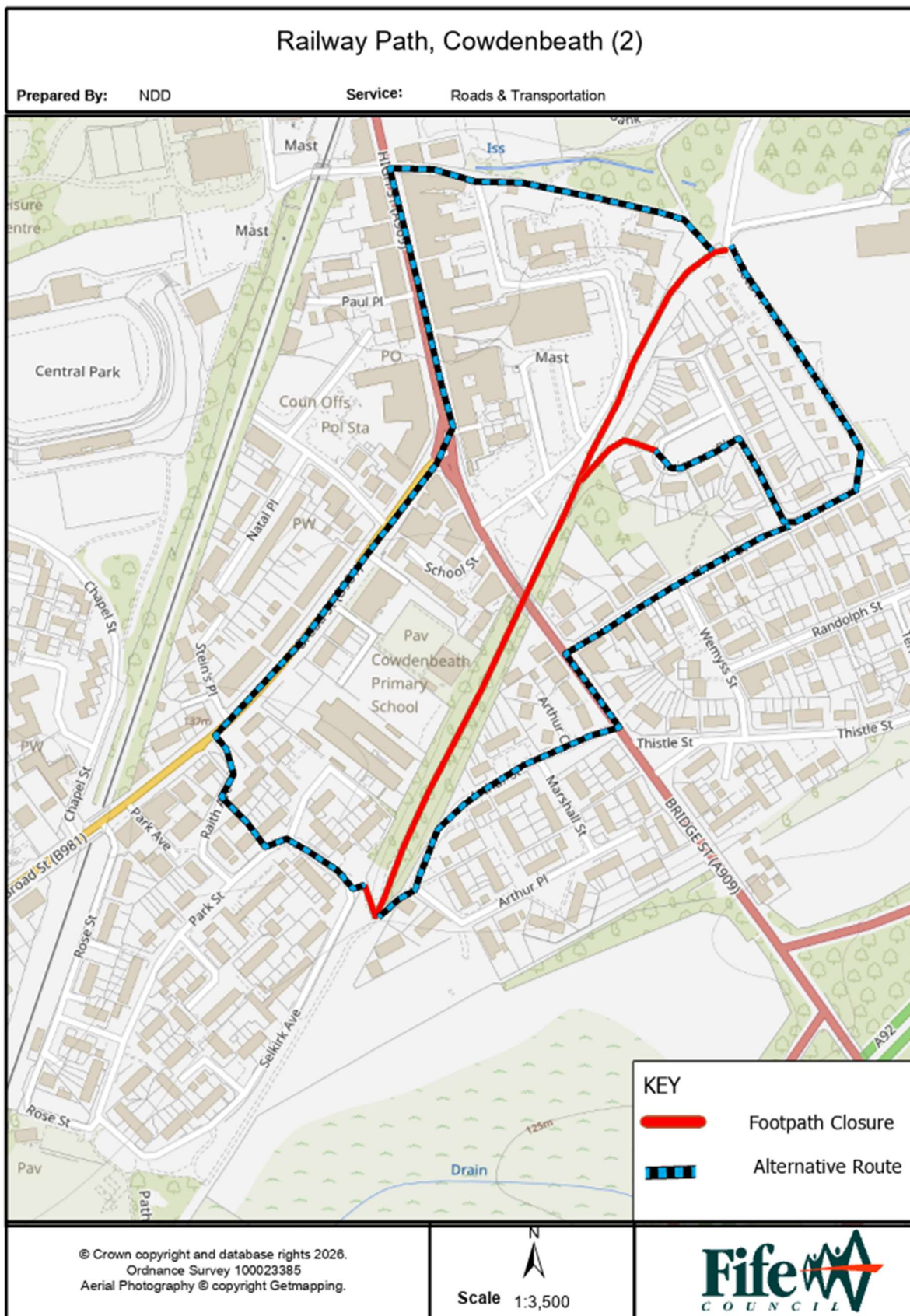
