
NOTICE OF CONSULTATION ON DISPOSAL OR CHANGE OF USE OF COMMON GOOD PROPERTY

Fife Council propose to change the use of a common good property: Land adjacent Scoonie Golf Course, North Links, Leven. British Telecommunications plc have requested permission to locate 3 x 9 metre light wooden telegraph poles on [3 sites] at Scoonie Golf Course Leven in terms of the Electronic Communications Code.

As this will change the current use of the 3 sites from [open space] to [telegraph pole], before taking a decision to change the use, Fife Council requires to consult with the community in terms of Section 104 of the Community Empowerment (Scotland) Act 2015.
