THE FIFE COUNCIL (STRATHORE ROAD, THORNTON - SPEED LIMITS) ORDER 2026

Fife Council propose to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to introduce new speed limits on Strathore Road as follows:- **30mph speed limit** – from approx. 5 metres west of no. 74 westerly to approx. 5 metres west of Mid Strathore Cottage; **40mph speed limit** - from approx. 5 metres west of Mid Strathore Cottage westerly to approx. 65 metres west of Muirhead Cottage.

Full details of the proposals may be examined during opening hours at Fife Council Headquarters, Fife House, North Street, Glenrothes and via public access pc's at your closest library. The documents will also be available online at www.fife.gov.uk/notices

THE FIFE COUNCIL (STRATHORE ROAD, THORNTON - SPEED LIMITS) ORDER 2026

The Fife Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them under section 84(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police for the Council's area in accordance with section 124 of and Part III of Schedule 9 to the said Act hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as "The Fife Council (Strathore Road, Thornton - Speed Limits) Order 2026" and shall come into operation on the _____ day of _____.
2. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour on the length of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order.
3. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the length of road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order.
4. Nothing in this Order shall apply to any vehicle which falls within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
5. Drawing number TRO26/18 showing the roads affected by this Order delineated in black is annexed and signed as relative hereto.
