## Application for renting a home in Fife

If you are 16 years old or over you can apply for housing with the Fife Housing Register.

Fife Housing Register (FHR) is a shared housing list. By filling in this form you can be considered by all the partners who have homes in the areas where you want to live.

In Fife more people need homes than there are properties to rent. Offering housing is decided using waiting lists and policies. The FHR website includes information about applying for housing and how your application is assessed. The website also includes a Housing Options Assessment tool. This gives you the opportunity to complete a personalised Housing Options Assessment in relation to your current circumstances to find out what housing options may be available to you.

Once you have completed and returned your application to a partner office (see opposite and back page of this form), we will assess your application and get back to you within 20 days if we need any additional information. Once your application has been fully assessed we will write to tell you:

- How your application has been assessed and the points you have been awarded
- The category your application has been placed in
- Any information we still need that could affect your application
- How to enquire about your application

If you don't hear from us within 20 days please contact us to discuss, by calling 03451 55 00 33, visiting any partner office or Fife Council Customer Service Centre.

If your circumstances change this may affect how your application is assessed. Make sure you update us of any changes to your circumstances.

## **About you**

## 1. About you

This information will be used to confirm your identity when processing your form or if you contact us about your application. Include your National Insurance Number.

If you want to apply jointly with someone else, their details should be written on the following page. If you don't live together at the moment, fill in an application form for each of you. This lets us assess your housing circumstances fully.

### 2. Tenancy details

If you, or anyone you want to apply jointly with, are a tenant of any of the FHR partners (listed) then please tick the box. Please also write your tenancy reference here. Even if you do not live at this address at the moment we still need to know that you are a tenant. If you don't know your tenancy reference, check your rent card (if you have one) or letters that you have been sent. Check with your landlord if you are not sure.

### 3. Your address

Please write the address where you normally live. This is the address we will use to contact you. Make sure that we have an up-to-date address for you at all times. If we write to you and you do not respond your application may be withdrawn. If you live between addresses please give us a contact address and mark this 'care of'.

If you want mail to go to a different address, please write the address you would like us to use in the space provided. If you are using a mailing address please ensure you have permission to use the address.

### 4. Your contact details

Please provide us with contact details we can use to get in touch with you and keep these updated at all times.

Our preferred method of contact during the processing of your application is by email. If this doesn't suit please say.

## 5. Link to Fife

If you currently, and normally, live in Fife then this is your link to Fife and you do not have to show any other link. If you are applying from outwith Fife, please tick the box that best describes your link to Fife. Where you are looking to establish a link to Fife we need you to provide proof, this may be:

- Anything that may be relevant to a different connection you may have

Where a link to Fife cannot be established, you will still be accepted onto the housing list. Your application will be assessed according to your circumstances.

## 6. General information

### **Homeless**

If you are homeless or might become homeless in the near future then please let us know. Call 03451 550033 to discuss your housing situation. This will ensure that your application is considered appropriately and you will be given all of the advice and assistance that we can offer.

#### **Anti Social Behaviour**

Any previous action taken against you or your joint applicant will be considered in line with FHR rules on Anti Social Behaviour. You must declare any history of complaints of Anti Social Behaviour against you or your joint applicant. This does not necessarily mean that you will not be offered a property.

### Sex Offenders Act 1997 or Sexual Offences Act 2003

A requirement to register under the Act will not affect the assessment of your application but may affect where you could be housed.

### **Asylum and Immigration**

Council housing is regarded as a form of public assistance therefore, if you are not eligible for public assistance, the council will be limited in terms of the assistance it can offer. These restrictions do not apply in the same way to Housing Associations therefore your application will be registered and assessed on your individual circumstances.

All information in your application is held securely and only made available to those with a need to know.

## 7. Representation

You may find dealing with your application difficult. If you want another person to represent you such as a relative, friend or legal adviser, please tell us here. If you appoint a representative, all Partners taking part in FHR can give information about your application to your representative. You cannot hold any Partner liable for information shared with your representative.

## 2. Domestic and Sexual Abuse

Domestic abuse is any type of controlling, bullying, threatening or violent behaviour between two people in a relationship. But it isn't just physical violence, it includes emotional, physical, sexual, financial or psychological abuse. Abusive behaviour can happen in any relationship. It can continue even after the relationship has ended. Both men and women can be abused or be abusers.


